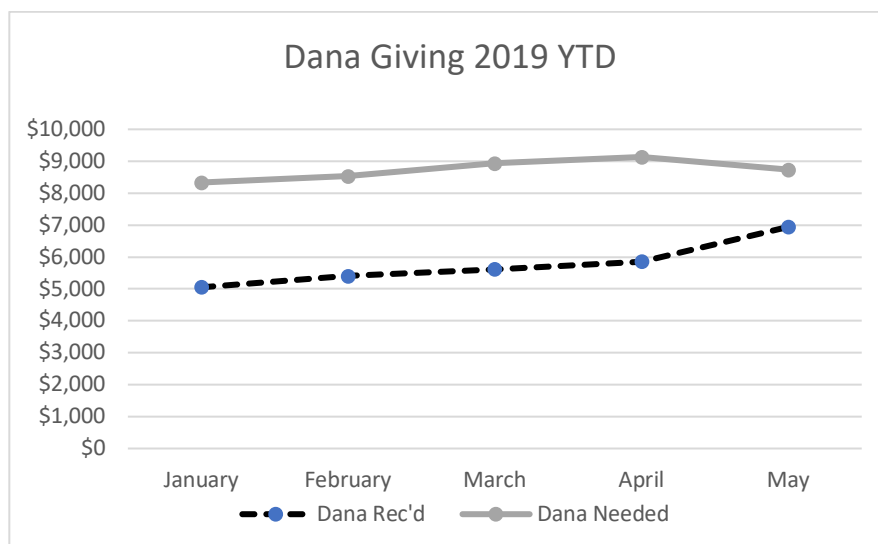


Vipassana: Seeing Things As They Really Are
